

Frequently Asked Questions

Where do I begin? Contact us and counseling forms will be sent to you. Once these forms are completed and returned, a counselor will contact you to set up an initial session.

How often will I meet with a counselor? The sessions will occur once a week and typically last 50-60 minutes. Generally, the counselor and counselee will meet for 10-12 sessions, although some situations might require fewer or more meetings.

What is required of me? 1) You will need to attend each session on time, unless providentially hindered. 2) You will be expected to complete the weekly homework assigned from the previous session. 3) You will be required to attend a Bible-teaching church. 4) You will be expected to see the counseling through to its conclusion.

What will it cost me? We provide this counseling free of charge as a ministry of Fellowship Baptist Church. However, you will be expected to pay for any materials supplied, such as booklets or CDs.

What if I am single? As a safety precaution, counselors will not meet alone with counsees of the opposite sex. Another trainer may attend the counseling session. It is strongly encouraged that the counselee bring another person (spouse, parent, friend) to also attend the sessions.


Directions
